

Calgary Urban Recycling (CUR) is pleased to announce that we have implemented a recycling program for your building starting November 7, 2015.

What can be recycled

	<p>Paper: Newspaper, catalogues and magazines, mixed paper (like flyers, envelopes and office paper), shredded paper, telephone books</p>		<p>Refundable beverage containers</p>
	<p>Boxboard and corrugated cardboard</p>		<p>Plastic containers with the recycling symbols 1-7, except polystyrene foam</p>
	<p>Glass jars and bottles</p>		<p>Plastic bags. All bags must be placed inside one bag and tied up</p>
	<p>Food cans and foil</p>		<p>Juice boxes and soup boxes (such as TetraPaks™)</p>

How to prepare your recycling

Make sure the all recyclable material is prepared properly:

- Remove any food residue from your jars and cans
- Flatten your cardboard boxes to save space
- *Please only include the items listed on this page*

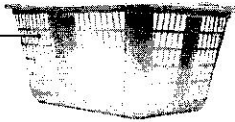
